LEGISLATION.

Assembly Bill 1955 was signed by Gavin Newsom on Monday July 15 that "overrules school boards with policies in place requiring that schools be transparent with parents about their child's perceived sexual orientation or gender identity, an issue that remains an active subject of debate especially given its potentially life-altering consequences. California is the first state to adopt such legislation and it remains to be seen whether other Democratic states follow its example. www.nationalreview.com/news/newsom-signs-law-barring-schools-from-requiring-that-parents-be-informed-of-child-gender-transition/

This is immediately being challenged in courts. "By Tuesday evening, the conservative nonprofit Liberty Justice Center said it had <u>filed a lawsuit</u> challenging the new law on behalf of Chino Valley Unified, which passed a parental notification policy last year." https://edsource.org/2024/newsom-signs-bill-to-end-parental-notification-policies-at-schools-but-opponents-say-its-not-over-yet/715767
