**Loren Spivack**  
"The Free Market Warrior"

Loren is a popular speaker at Republican and conservative events all over the United States. He has been the keynote speaker at state Republican Women Federated conventions in Virginia, California, Arizona and Nevada. Loren was, along with Kelly Ann Conway, the keynote speaker at the Delaware state Republican Convention in April of 2023. Finally, Loren spoke at both the California and Oregon State Federation of Republican Women in 2025.

Always with a fresh take, Loren examines the issues of our time through the eyes of an economist and reveals fundamental truths underlying the political challenges we face.

He speaks on a very wide variety of topics both narrowly focused (e.g. "The Path not Taken: Fixing American Healthcare with Capitalism.") and very broad (e.g. Why We Fight. Understanding The Modern Left")

Steve was born in London, the son of Hungarian immigrants who fled communism in search of freedom and opportunity. From a working-class background Steve made it to Oxford University and then a career at the highest levels of business and politics. Steve worked as senior advisor to Prime Minister David Cameron before immigrating to the United States. His first job - and the one that taught him the most important lessons of his professional life - was Project Manager for a construction company in London.

Since moving to California, Steve has taught at Stanford University, started and built several businesses of his own, hosted Fox News' The Next Revolution, and launched Golden Together, a movement for common-sense reform in California. He is the author of More Human (2015), Positive Populism (2018), and Califailure (2024).

Steve is not a career politician. He's an outsider with the business and government experience to take on the insiders, end the bloat, and fight for the people who make California work.

# LEGISLATION

## Legislative Analysis

### State

**Voter ID Initiative** – Looks like there will be enough signatures to get on November ballot, but we are still collecting more just in case. Also remind everyone: 1) Voter ID will allow for mail-in balloting and 2) although you are asked for ID to register to vote, ID is not required. Fraudsters are taking advantage of this loophole. (Signature Collection)

**Save Prop 13 Initiative** – Stop Tax Increases – 1978 Prop 13 limited property tax increases and required a 2/3 vote to increase other types of taxes. Dems have found a loophole: CA courts are allowing tax increases passed by a simple majority if the tax was placed on the ballot as a citizen's initiative. Unions and non-profits that benefit from tax increases are now placing initiatives on the ballot and collecting signatures. Save Prop 13 closes this loophole by requiring a 2/3 vote for any tax increase placed on the ballot. (Signature Collection)

**Prop 50** – California Redistricting - It's not over yet. Map author, Paul Mitchell, was recorded describing how the new map would create districts based on race, which is illegal. California Republicans filed an emergency injunction with the Supreme Court. The Supreme Court has given California until 1/29 to respond.

**AB 1157** – Rent Control – (Did not move forward)

**SB 79** – Upzoning Density - Overrides local density limits to allow high-density housing development within one-half mile of qualifying transit stops (passed)

**SB 73** - Prohibits elections officials from permitting feds to inspect a voting system machine or device without court order (In progress)

**SB 560** - Decriminalizes welfare fraud. (In progress)

**SB 608** - Mandates school-based health centers to distribute condoms to students. (In progress)

**AB 1421** - Requires CA Transportation Commission to prepare research and recommendations related to a road user charge or a mileage-based fee system (In progress)

**Senate Constitutional Amendment 1 (SCA 1)** – School Choice and Special Education Flex Accounts (In progress)

**Bonds, Bonds, and More Spending** – **SB 417** (Affordable Housing), **SB 492** (Youth Housing), **SB 895** (Health Research)

### Federal

**SAVE Act** – Amends the 1993 National Voter Registration Act to require proof of citizenship in order to register to vote. Voters would need to present a passport or enhanced (citizenship-verified) drivers license (only available in several states, not California) to register. If a voter doesn't have these, they would need to present a photo ID AND birth certificate. Differs from Reform California Voter ID initiative which only requires the last 4 digits of a driver's license or SSN to vote. Citizenship verification becomes a responsibility of the state. (in progress)

**Big Election Integrity Win** – Supreme Court ruled 7-2 in *Bost VS. the Illinois State Board of Elections* that candidates for Federal Office have standing challenge ballot counting. Credit Judicial Watch.



# ACTIVISM

## With midterms approaching, we face multiple deadlines and important matters to discuss with others.

As of 1/27/26 there are 91 registered candidates on our San Diego County ballot. The winners will shape the future of life in our city and state, for good or for bad! According to Jim Desmond, current Board of Supervisor Dist. 5, there are major issues proposed and pending:

### County of San Diego:

- Half-cent countywide sales tax for the 2026 ballot
- One-time real estate transfer fee on the top 1% of transactions
- Documentary Transfer Tax hike – from \$.055 per \$500 up to \$30.55 per \$500 (over a 5,000% increase!)
- Push to allow a new payroll tax on workers and employers ( I wonder if this applies to robots?)
- Additional new taxes and fees being developed by the county’s Fiscal Sustainability Committee – including ideas similar to LA’s failed “Mansion Tax”

### City of San Diego (Proposed and already approved):

- Short-term Rental/Vacation Home Tax (potentially on the 2026 ballot)
- One-cent citywide sales tax pushed by labor unions
- Balboa Park parking fees (already in effect and causing a massive decline in park visits)
- Water rate increase of 14.7% (this is due to SD County Water Authority pushing PLA’s – Project Labor Agreements - resulting in single-bid jobs and backroom deals)
- Wastewater rate increase of 6%
- New trash collection fees, already in effect and hitting our property tax bills
- Higher recreation and user fees in the City’s FY 2026 budget

Meanwhile, **San Diego County has adopted the largest budget in its history** and is collecting record revenues yet faces a \$300 million deficit! According to the Transparency Foundation’s latest study, the cost of living for a middle-class family is \$29,753 higher than the national average. We need to stop all new taxes to protect families and small businesses who are being pushed out of the state.

I’m excited to see Conservatives statewide running for office, offering to take on the challenges of our Golden State. Let’s get out there and help them, whether it’s volunteering for a candidate or helping fund their campaign. The filing deadline is February 4<sup>th</sup> for candidates in the June 2<sup>nd</sup> primary.

There is a new center-right alternative to Liberal media in California, **The CA Post** (owned by the NY Post) posted its first edition featuring an article by Carl DeMaio. # VETERAN OUTREACH

**Foundation for Women Warriors** continues as our military organization to support. They support women veterans and their families, who need assistance transitioning to civilian life. The Foundation provides clothing, baby items, networking for furthering education and employment, and financial assistance on a short term to those who served.

On their website, they will have a special screening on February 18<sup>th</sup> from 4-6 p.m., **The Six Triple Eight** documentary. In 1945, the U.S. Army needed help processing backlogged mail to the soldiers. The Women's Army Corps (WAC) deployed 855 women to England and France to process a massive backlog of mail. The women were from the 6888<sup>th</sup> Central Postal Directory Battalion and were the only all-black, all female battalion to serve in Europe during World War II. They completed their mission in six months, clearing 17 million pieces of backlogged mail. They were never fully recognized until now.....

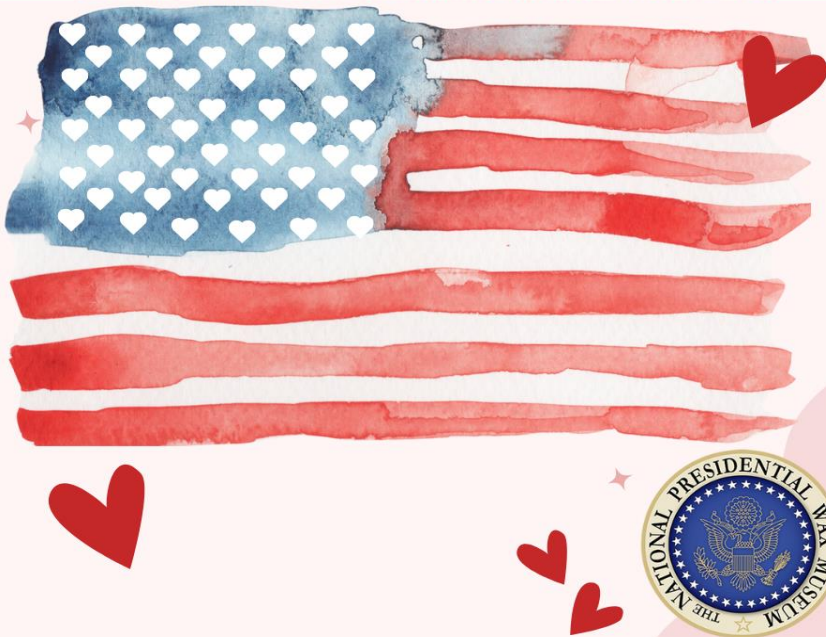

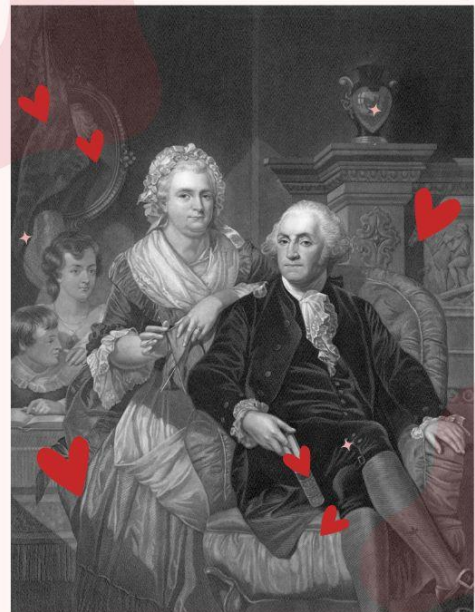
PRESIDENTIAL LOVE STORIES FOR VALENTINES DAY

## 5. Ronald & Nancy Reagan: A Hollywood Love Story in the White House

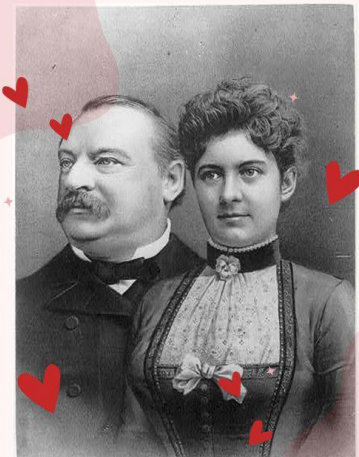

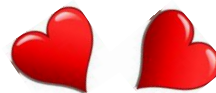
