PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I am feeling encouraged as I sit down to write this President's Message.

After scanning the major news outlets for the headlines of the day — really, the hour — I often turn to the app X to see what every day Americans are saying. It's fascinating, heartening, enlightening, humbling, rallying — and yes, sometimes upsetting — to scroll through the conversations unfolding in real time.

Recently, I saw a video of a man passionately saying, "Stop insulting California — instead, PRAY FOR US!" He believes California is far more red than blue. He sees tremendous support behind common-sense issues, yet after each election, the same blue outcomes prevail. With the heavily Democrat-controlled cities of Los Angeles, San Francisco, and Sacramento, one-party control continues to dominate state policy and direction. Meanwhile, too many voters remain apathetic and don't make it to the polls.

Still, there is much to be encouraged about:

- An email from Reform California announcing they have secured enough signatures to place Voter ID on the November ballot! Carl's vision, "26 in 2026," a strategy to win the 2026 midterms, protect Prop 13, block tax hikes, expose corruption and waste through DOGE CA, and flip key target seats. If voters approve Voter ID, many of these goals become far more achievable.
- The Republican Party of San Diego County is sharpening its focus on supporting GOP candidates and launching an aggressive GET OUT THE VOTE effort. Getting our voters to the polls will absolutely increase Republican turnout and representation.
- Governor Gavin Newsom may be so politically damaged that a 2028 presidential run becomes unrealistic. On the national and world stage, he continues to pander to his audience, criticize federal leadership while claiming superior solutions, and insist California's economy is thriving — even as families and businesses continue to leave the state.
- His young communications director has drawn attention for foul-mouthed exchanges with reporters and for earning a taxpayer-funded salary exceeding \$212,000 — raising serious questions about priorities and accountability.
- I understand that journalist Nick Shirley has recently visited California twice. It may be uncomfortable to see what he uncovers, but shining light on truth is always healthy.
- Bronze winning Bobsled Olympian Kaillie Humphries declares she is a Republican and wants to serve on the White House Task Force for the 2028 Summer Olympics in LA.
- We currently have two strong Republican candidates running for governor, compared to a crowded field of less compelling Democrat contenders competing for a runoff spot.
- The Epstein Files....
- I could go on and on.

Now is not the time for discouragement — it's the time for action.

Get involved. Attend our meetings and hear directly from local candidates. Support them enthusiastically — and financially, if you are able — as we work to flip targeted seats. Learn about tools that help identify neighbors who share our values and may simply need encouragement to vote. Sign the petition to "Save Prop 13" and protect property owners from higher taxes.

Most importantly — PRAY FOR CALIFORNIA.

Let's stay energized, engaged, and united.

San Diego

Vacation Rental/Empty Second Home Tax (Status: did not make it out of committee. Councilman Elo-Rivera presenting the Empty Home Tax to the Council again next week for placement on the June ballot.

Balboa Park Parking – Following significant protest, verified city residents will now be able to park for free in the Pepper Grove, Federal, Upper Inspiration Point and Lower Inspiration Point, Marston Point, Palisades and Bea Evenson lots.

California

Voter ID – Looks like it has enough raw signatures to make the ballot

Prop 13 – Looks like it has enough raw signatures to make the ballot.

AB 1608 – Proposes to bar the Inspector General from sharing High Speed Rail “project weaknesses” from the public. This is literally anti-transparency legislation. (Status: Referred to Committee)

AB 1421 Milage Tax – Could cost Californian’s \$1000’s per year. (Status: Passed the CA State Assembly and referred to committee assignment in Senate.)

AB 1900 “CALCARE” - Will socialize healthcare in CA. Carl DeMaio estimates a \$500 billion dollar tax hike paid by for by an excise tax, payroll tax, and progressive income tax. Private healthcare would be banned. (Status: Introduced)

SB 1422 – Medicare for Undocumented Immigrants aged 19 and older. (Status: Introduced)

National



HR 7296 Save America Act – (Status: Passed House. Probably can’t pass Senate without a filibuster.) **John Thune**, U.S. Senator from South Dakota and current Senate Majority Leader seems very reluctant to proceed with the filibuster. If this act does not pass, we will not have a country anymore as we know it. Republicans will never win an election again. The **State of the Union** on February 24th had it all! Tears, cheers, spectacle, awards! It began with a rousing chant of “USA!” and was the longest SOTU (State of the Union) in history, lasting 108 minutes, with President Trump inspiring 166 standing ovations. He addressed issues such as restricting insider stock trading and the closed border. He touted the lowest murder rate in 125 years, pushed Congress to pass the SAVE Act to require proof of citizenship to vote, encouraged them to restore funding to DHS and end the partial shutdown, asked Congress to ban corporations from buying Single-Family homes to make ownership attainable for more Americans, along with lower interest rates. He has appointed VP Vance to lead a war on Fraud and Corruption. He has negotiated a Taxpayer Protection Pledge which will require major corporations to provide their own power sources for AI Data Centers. He’s ensuring that lower health care costs benefit the patient, not the health insurance companies. His executive order ended DEI (Diversity, Equity and Inclusion) in the Federal Government and the private sector.

In addition to Making America Great Again, President Trump addressed the sacrifices Americans have made, including the two National Guard soldiers attacked in DC by an Afghan terrorist. One, a 20 year old guard, was killed, and her mother was applauded for her daughter’s sacrifice. The surviving guard barely recovered (thanks to his loving Mom!) and was given the Purple Heart. A 100 year old Korean War veteran (from Escondido!) was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor by our First Lady. The lead helicopter pilot in the capture of Maduro in Venezuela, who was shot 4 times in his legs and still completed his mission, was rightly given the Congressional Medal of Honor. Maduro’s opponent, who was captured and imprisoned after their stolen election, was reunited with his niece in a surprise event. I was brought to tears by Charlie Kirk’s widow, Erika Kirk, and by the mother of Iryna Zarutka, the young Ukrainian woman who was killed on a commuter train by a criminal with a lengthy arrest record who was out on bail due to our weak legal system. The president vowed justice for her and all others harmed by criminals who should not be out on the streets.

It was fun to see the US Hockey team celebrating their Olympic Gold Medal win and their goalie was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom!

What a night. Except for half of the room who either boycotted the event or objected to all the Winning. We now know that Democrats value Illegal aliens over Americans. SO SAD. But let’s keep working on making our country, our state and our beautiful San Diego the best place on this big planet.

Late edition summary from the Whitehouse regarding military action on February 28th

"President Donald J. Trump announces the start of major combat operations in Iran. The objective is to defend the American people by eliminating threats from the Iranian regime, described as a "vicious group of very hard, terrible people".

President Trump highlights a history of Iranian aggression, including:

- Chanting "death to America" for 47 years;
- Backing the violent takeover of the US embassy in Tehran and holding American hostages for 444 days.
- Proxies carrying out the Marine barracks bombing in Beirut in 1983, killing 241 American military personnel.
- Involvement in the attack on the USS Cole in 2000.
- Killing and maiming hundreds of American service members in Iraq.
- Launching countless attacks against American forces and vessels in the Middle East.
- Arming, training, and funding terrorist militias from Lebanon to Yemen, Syria, and Iraq.
- Iran's proxy Hamas launching the October 7th attacks on Israel, slaughtering over 1,000 innocent people, including 46 Americans.

President Trump emphasizes that Iran is the world's number one state sponsor of terror and stresses that the regime "can never have a nuclear weapon". Trump states that in "Operation Midnight Hammer" last June, the regime's nuclear program was obliterated at Ford Natans and Isvahan. Despite warnings and attempts to make a deal, Iran refused to renounce its nuclear ambitions, instead attempting to rebuild its program and develop long-range missiles.

To prevent this "wicked, radical dictatorship" from threatening America, the United States military is undertaking a massive ongoing operation to:

- Destroy their missiles and raise their missile industry to the ground.
- Annihilate their navy.
- Ensure terrorist proxies can no longer destabilize the region or attack US forces.
- Ensure Iran does not obtain a nuclear weapon.

President Trump warns of potential US casualties but frames it as a "noble mission" for the future. He calls on members of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard, armed forces and police to lay down their weapons for complete immunity or face "certain death". Finally, President Trump addresses the people of Iran, stating that their "hour of freedom is at hand", advising them to stay sheltered due to danger and encouraging them to "take over your government" when the operation is finished, asserting this is possibly their "only chance for generations" as America is backing them with "overwhelming strength and devastating force".

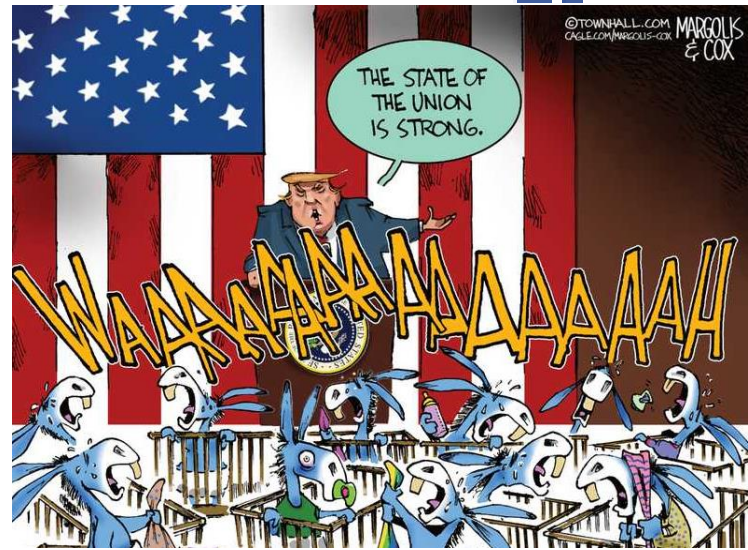

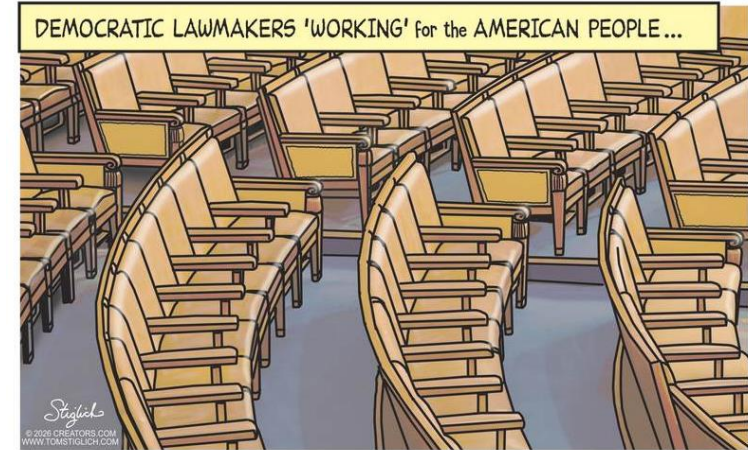

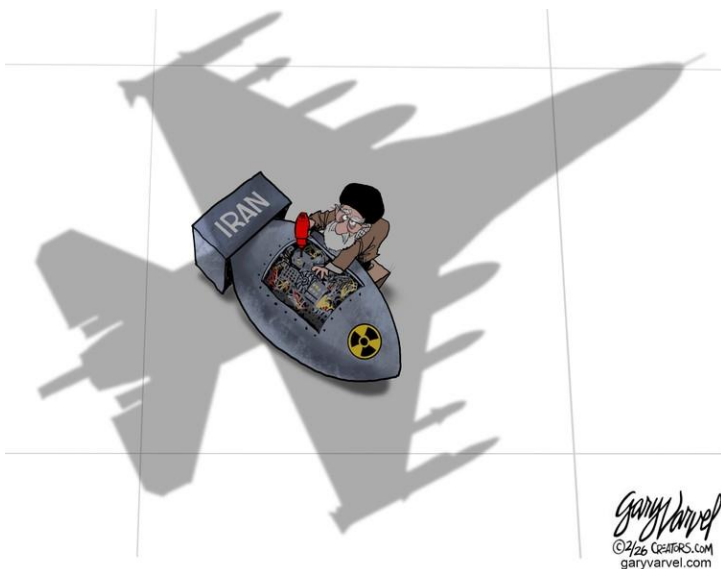
